

Maa-Beti Sammelan Programme 2026

Under the guidance of Hon'ble Chancellor Smt. Anandiben Patel and the leadership of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Ajay Taneja, the Maa-Beti Sammelan programme, a blood sample collection drive for girl students was successfully organized on 1st July 2026 at Atal Sabhagarh at Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Language University as part of *Deekshotsav-2026*. The programme was coordinated by Dr. Nalini Mishra, with enthusiastic participation from students, teachers, and staff.

As part of Deekshotsav-2026, a special health check-up camp was organized for female students with the aim of promoting awareness about health and nutrition. In the camp, blood tests, BMI measurements, and blood pressure examinations were conducted. Specialist doctors also provided important guidance to the students regarding balanced diet, regular health check-ups, and adopting a healthy lifestyle.
